The club membership fees will be \$20.00 for the 1994 season.


JOTA at Camp Samac was on Saturday October 16th 1993.

The decision to move the repeater will be delayed until next year to give more time to study the proposed repeater sites, and the move


of the two repeaters, VE3OSH and VE3NAA will be targeted for the late spring.
