

PLEASE NOTE!!!!! THERE HAS BEEN A MAJOR CHANGE IN THE PLANS OF THE COMMITTEE RELATIVE TO THE LOCATION OF THIS EVENT. AS PREVIOUSLY REPORTED, THE FLEA MARKET WAS TO HAVE BEEN HELD IN THE METRO EAST TRADE CENTRE ON BROCK ROAD, PICKERING, WHICH, DESPITE ITS EXPECTED COSTS, HAD DISTINCT ADVANTAGES IN SPACE AND PARKING FACILITIES.
