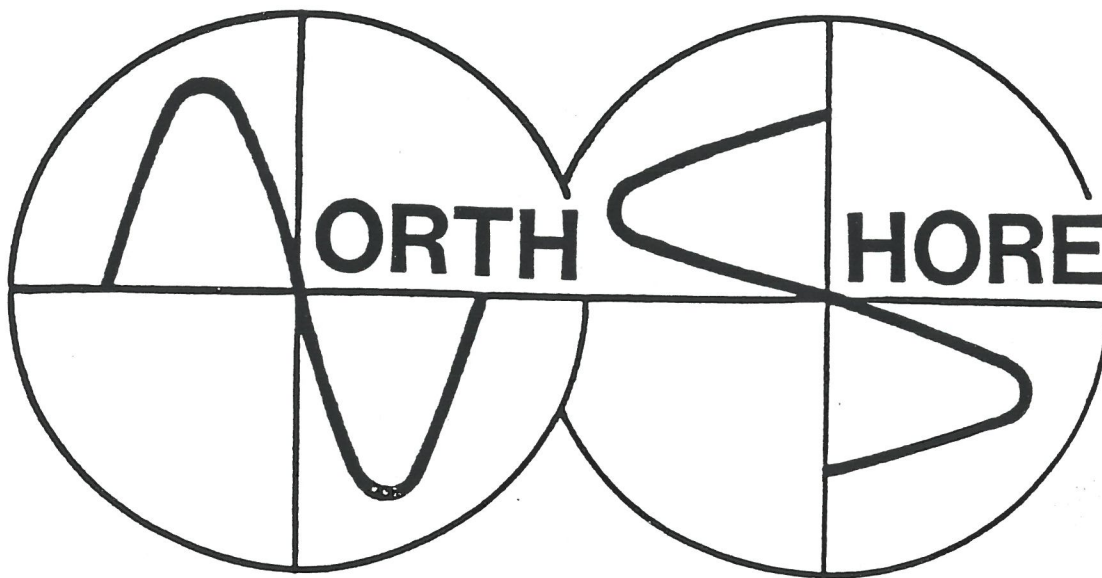

AT THE MAY MEETING OF THE CLUB, HARRY (QG) INFORMED US THAT OUR CLUB HAD BEEN GIVEN FIRST REFUSAL ON AN OPERATING 400 MHZ REPEATER. THE OWNER OF THE EQUIPMENT, RICK FRANZ (IFI) WILL BE MOVING TO VE4 LAND (MUCH SOONER THAN HE EXPECTED) AND HE EITHER HAD TO SELL IT BY MAY 22, 1987 OR PULL THE PLUG.

AS A PUBLIC SERVICE, THE OWNER OF THE TOWER ON WHICH THE ANTENNAE RESIDE AND THE BUILDING HOUSING THE EQUIPMENT, BILL BURRELL, WOULD LIKE TO SEE THE REPEATER MAINTAINED FOR EMERGENCY COMMUNICATION EXERCISES (AND, IT GOES WITHOUT SAYING, REAL EMERGENCIES), AND, SINCE THIS WOULD TIE IN SOCIAL SERVICES' 400 MHZ. EQUIPMENT, WOULD SEEM TO BE WORTH ACQUIRING.

DUE TO THE EXTREMELY SHORT TIME AVAILABLE FOR DECISION-MAKING A CLUB MEMBER, PERSONALY, PURCHASED THE EQUIPMENT AND WE WILL HAVE MORE ON THIS AT THE SEPTEMBER MEETING.

THE EQUIPMENT, WHICH HAS BEEN OPERATING FLAWLESSLY DURING ITS THREE YEAR EXISTANCE, IS LOCATED JUST ABOUT 1/2 MILE EAST OF THE VE3OSH REPEATER LOCATION, ON A HILL WHICH IS 1025' ABOVE SEA LEVEL. THE TRANSMIT ANTENNA IS LOCATED ON TOP OF A 250' TOWER WITH THE RECEIVE ANTENNA SIDE-MOUNTED SLIGHTLY LOWER DOWN. COVERAGE IS EXCELLENT (FOR INSTANCE, THE REPEATER CAN BE WORKED MOBILE FROM PETERBOROUGH) AND GLORY BE! DESPITE SHARING THE ANTENNA WITH COMMERCIAL STATIONS IT'S INTERMOD FREE! IT IS ALSO LESS AFFECTED BY AN INVERSION.

THE REPEATER EQUIPMENT ITSELF, CONSISTS OF A SOLID-STATE PYE "WESTMINSTER" RIG RUNNING 5 WATTS TO A P.A. CAPABLE OF 50 WATTS OUTPUT, A BASIC LOGIC CIRCUIT FOR TIMER/IDENTIFIER, CARRIER OPERATED RELAY CIRCUIT, XTAL OSC'S. GAS FET RECEIVER, PRE-AMPLIFIER AND POWER SUPPLY. TIMER IS ABOUT 2 MINS. 45 SECS.

IF YOU HAVE 400 MHZ EQUIPMENT, THE FREQUENCIES ARE 443.00 OUT AND 448.00 IN. IF YOU CAN'T ACCESS THE REPEATER YOURSELF BUT WOULD LIKE TO KNOW MORE ABOUT IT, TALK TO SOME OF THE LOCALS WHO USE IT SUCH AS ATI, AZT, RP, KSP, LLE, HE, BIC, HMG, GTS, MUH, NSO, & MDV.
