

OLYMPIC NEWS

THIS HEADING MAY BE A LITTLE MISLEADING SINCE THE OLYMPICS ARE FINISHED AS FAR AS THE ATHLETES ARE CONCERNED BUT WE HAVE NEWS FROM OLYMPICLAND THAT EVEN NBC DOESN'T KNOW ABOUT.

AS REPORTED EARLIER, KEITH (EX VE3DZM) MOVED TO CALGARY AT THE FIRST OF THE YEAR (HE WANTED TO START THE NEW YEAR RIGHT). NEEDLESS TO SAY, HE TOOK HIS HAM GEAR WITH HIM AND, AS YOU MAY HAVE GUESSED. APPLIED FOR A NEW CALL. HE IS NOW VE6DZM AND HAS JOINED THE CALGARY AMATEUR RADIO ASSOCIATION WHICH BOASTS A MEMBERSHIP OF 200 BUT HAD (AT THE TIME OF WRITING-FEB 08) NOT YET ATTENDED A MEETING. HE HAD MEI WITH A FEW OF THE MEMBERS (INCLUDING OUR FORMER PRESIDENT DON COLE (VE6EY)) AT A COFFEE WHICH IS APPARENTLY A REGULAR SATURDAY MORNING GET-TOGETHER.

WHILE ON THE SUBJECT OF DON, I MUST APOLOGIZE TO BOTH DON AND THOSE OF YOU WHO DID NOT RECEIVE PAGES 3 AND 7 OF THE FEBRUARY BULLETIN. THE PRINTER HAD IGNORED OUR REQUEST TO HAVE 4 PAGES PRINTED ON BOTH SIDES AND THE WEIGHT OF 8 SHEETS WAS MORE THAN OUR SUPPLY OF STAMPS WOULD CARRY SO COLIN (VE3CEU) AND I (THE EDITOR) MADE A HASTY DECISION AND REMOVED THE ONLY TWO SHEETS THAT CONTAINED ONLY I ITEM EACH; SHEET 3 WAS A REPRINT OF THE MAP TO OUR NEW MEETING PLACE, WHICH WE HAD ALREADY GIVEN YOU, AND THE OTHER, UNFORTUNATELY, WAS A LETTER FROM DON (VE6EY) WHICH WE, BELATEDLY, REMEMBERED HAD SUPPLIED SOME RATHER INTERESTING INFORMATION ABOUT AMATEUR RADIO ACTIVITY (UNOFFICIALLY THROUGH VOLUNTEERING WITH OTHER GROUPS) CONNECTED TO OR PERTAINING TO THE OLYMPICS. IN HIS LETTER, DON MENTIONED THAT HE WAS WORKING WITH THE CITY OF CALGARY POLICE AS A VOLUNTEER ON SECURITY IN THE PALLISTER HOTEL WHERE SOME OF THE OLYMPIC COMMITTEE AND SOME ROYALTY WOULD BE STAYING. DON ALSO MENTIONED THAT HE HAS TAKEN UP CROSS-COUNTRY SKIING AND ONE OF THEIR PUBLIC SERVICE EVENTS IS A RACE IN THE BEAUTIFUL KANENAKIS COUNTRY.

TABLO S ANGESTONS OF HOM TRANS S SYEATTERY

(EDITOR'S NOTE--SOMEONE IN THE YORK REGION CLUB SEEMS TO HAVE A GREAT INTEREST IN RADIO'S ANCESTORS AND PRODUCES SOME VERY INTERESTING OLD ARTICLES ON THEIR LIVES. I AM INDEBTED TO HIM FOR THE FOLLOWING)

MARCONI--THE GREATEST NAME IN RADIO (FROM CANADIAN BROADCASTER-- 1946)

IT WAS AN OBITUARY THAT SPURRED MARCONI TO ACHIEVE THE FIRST WIRELESS COMMUNICATION. AT THE AGE OF 20, SO THE STORY GOES, HE CAME ACROSS THE OBITUARY OF HEINRICH HERTZ WHILE ON A MOUNTAINEERING VACATION.

HERTZ, WHO DIED IN 1894, WAS THE GERMAN SCIENTIST WHO, 7 YEARS EARLIER, HAD PROVED THE EXISTENCE OF ELECTRO-MAGNETIC WAVES. THE ARTICLE SO FIRED MARCONI'S ENTHUSIASMAND KINDLED HIS IMAGINATION THAT HE COULD HARDLY WAIT TO GET HOME TO ITALYAND START EXPERIMENTING. BY 1896 HE WAS ABLE TO ANNOUNCE TO THE WORLD THAT COMMUNICATION WITHOUT WIRES HAD BEEN ACHIEVED OVER A DISTANCE OF MORE THAN A MILE.

GUGLIEMO MARCONI WAS BORN APRIL 25.1874 AT BALOGNA, ITALY. HIS FATHER WAS ITALIAN AND HIS MOTHER WAS IRISH—WHICH HAD AN IMPORTANT BEARING ON THE FUTURE OF THE YOUNG MAN AND OF RADIO, BECAUSE HIS MOTHER TAUGHT HIM TO SPEAK ENGLISH AS FLUENTLY AS HE SPOKE HIS FATHER'S ITALIAN.

MARCONI'S GENIUS LAY NOT SO MUCH IN INVENTION AS IN VISION AND IMAGINATION. HE WAS A PRACTICAL MAN WHO SAW THE POSSIBILITIES OPENED UP BY THEORIES AND DISCOVERIES OF OTHER MEN. SUCH AS FARADAY, MAXWELL. AND HERTZ, AND APPLIED THEM TO HIS SEARCH FOR A MEANS TO COMMUNICATE WITHOUT WIRES. RECALLING HIS EARLIER EXPERIMENTS LATER ON. HE SAID: "IT SEEMED TO ME THAT IF THE RADIATION (OBSERVED BY HERTZ) COULD BE INCREASED. DEVELOPED, AND CONTROLLED. IT WOULD BE POSSIBLE TO SIGNAL ACROSS SPACE FOR CONSIDERABLE DISTANCES. MY CHIEF TROUBLE WAS THAT THE IDEA WAS SO ELEMENTARY. SO SIMPLE IN LOGIC. THAT IT SEEMED DIFFICULT TO BELIEVE THAT NO-ONE ELSE HAD THOUGHT OF PUTTING IT INTO PRACTICE."

THE ITALIAN GOVERNMENT, AT FIRST, TOOK NO INTEREST IN MARCONI'S ACHIEVEMENT, SO HE WENT TO ENGLAND, RESOLVED TO USE THE ENGLISH HIS MOTHER HAD TAUGHT HIM. TO EXPAND HIS GREAT VISION.

ON JUNE 2, 1986, HE TOOK OUT THE FIRST PATENT EVER ISSUED IN WIRELESS TELEGRAPH AND DEMONSTRATED HIS SYSTEM TO THE BRITISH POST OFFICE. WITH A PIONEERING SPIRIT RARE AMONG GOVERNMENT DEPARTMENTS, THE POST OFFICE PUT ITS BACKING BEHIND MARCONI; SIR WILLIAM PREECE, ENGINEER OF POSTAL AND TELEGRAPH SERVICE, CO-OPERATED WITH HIS EXPERIMENTS AND RAPID PROGRESS WAS MADE IN IMPROVING AND EXTENDING WIRELESS COMMUNICATION.

IN JULY 1987, MARCONI'S OPERATIONS WERE PUT ON A COMMERCIAL BASIS. THE WIRELESS TELEGRAPH AND SIGNAL CO. (LATER MARCONI'S WIRELESS TELEGRAPH CO.) WAS FORMED.

MEANWHILE, LLOYDS OF LONDON, FORSEING THE IMPORTANCE OF WIRELESS TO SHIPPING, ASKED MARCONI TO EXPERIMENT BETWEEN TWO LIGHTHOUSES, 7 1/2 MILES APART, IN NORTHERN IRELAND. ROCKY HILLS HID THEM FROM EACH OTHER BUT, NEVER-THE-LESS, CONTACT WAS ESTABLISHED.

IN 1897 WIRELESS WAS FIRST USED FOR SHIP-TO-SHORE COMMUNICATION; THE ITALIAN GOVERNMENT ASKED MARCONI TO SET UP A STATION AT LA SPEZIA WHICH CONTACTED WARSHIPS 12 MILES AWAY. BACK IN ENGLAND, WIRELESS WAS USED, IN 1898, FOR A LIGHTSHIP ON THE TREACHEROUS GOODWIN SANDS TO KEEP CONTACT WITH THE KENTISH COAST. WHEN THIS LIGHTSHIP WAS RAMMED BY A STEAMER IN A FOG, THE VALUE OF WIRELESS IN SAVING LIFE AT SEA WAS PROVED.

BY MARCH 1899, THE FIRST MESSAGE HAD BEEN TRANSMITTED 32 MILES ACROSS THE ENGLISH CHANNEL. THE NEXT YEAR, MARCONI WENT TO THE U.S. AND USED HIS EQUIPMENT TO REPORT THE 1900 PRESIDENTIAL ELECTION. IN 1901, WHEN HIS ANTENNA ON CAPE COD COLLAPSED, HE SET UP A STATION ON SIGNAL HILL, ST. JOHN'S, NEWFOUNDLAND WHERE HE HOPED TO RECEIVE THE FIRST TRANSALLANTIC WIRELESS MESSAGE FROM HIS STATION AT POLDHU IN CORNWALL, ENGLAND. THE SIGNAL TO BE TRANSMITTED WAS SIMPLY THE 'DI-DI-DIT' OF THE MORSE LETTER 'S'.

MARCONI HAD CONSTRUCTED A LARGE KITE TO CARRY HIS RECEIVING AERIAL AS HIGH AS POSSIBLE. AT THE APPOINTED TIME IN DECEMBER 1901, WHEN ALL WAS READY, HIS EQUIPMENT WAS FINALLY ADJUSTED AND-YES!, HE DID HEAR A FAINT SOUND- THE DI-DI-DIT OF THE PRE-ARRANGED SIGNAL, REPEATED OVER AND OVER AGAIN. IT WAS BARELY AUDIBLE BUT THERE WAS NO MISTAKING THE SOUND OF THOSE THREE DITS.

NOW THE POTENTIALITIES OF WORLD-WIDE RADIO COMMUNICATIONS BEGAN TO BE RECOGNIZED. MARCONI'S FEAT HAD PROVED THAT RADIO WAVES WERE NOT LIMITED IN RANGE BY THE CURVATURE OF THE EARTH.

THE ANGLO-AMERICAN CABLE COMPANY, WHICH CLAIMED A MONOPOLY OF COMMUNICATIONS IN NEWFOUNDLAND, FORCED MARCONI TO CONTINUE HIS EXPERIMENTS ELSEWHERE. HE MOVED TO A POINT ON TABLE HEAD, CAPE BRETON, NOVA SCOTIA. THE FIRST TRANSATLANTIC WIRELESS MESSAGE WAS SENT FROM THERE ON DECEMBER 21, 1902.

NOW BEGAN A PERIOD OF INTENSE RIVALRY BETWEEN THE SPROUTING MARCONI ORGANIZATION AND OTHERS WHO HAD ENTERED THE NEW FIELD. AS YET THERE WERE NO REGULATIONS TO GUIDE AND CONTROL THEIR OPERATIONS. IHE COMPETITION WAS KEEN AND THE BYWORD WAS 'EVERY MAN FOR HIMSELF'. THE MARCONI COMPANY BEGAN TO SET UP ITS OWN STATIONS AT STRATEGIC POINTS THROUGHOUT THE COUNTRIES OF THE BRITISH EMPIRE AND WHEREVER ELSE IF COULD SECURE A FOOTING. CHARGES OF 'MONOPOLY' BEGAN TO BE HEARD IN ENGLAND, AND STEPS WERE TAKEN TO LIMIT THE DOMINANCE WHICH THE MARCONI COMPANY HAD BUILT UP BY VIRTUE OF BEING FIRST IN THE FIELD IN BRITAIN, AND OF HAVING A MAN OF SUCH VISION AS GUGLIEMO MARCONI AT ITS HEAD. THE EASTERN TELEGRAPH COMPANY (LATER CABLE AND WIRELESS) SET UP ANIENNA TOWERS ON THE CORNISH: CLIFFS SO THEY COULD EAVES-DROP ON MARCONI'S ACTIVITIES —AN EARLY EXAMPLE OF INDUSTRIAL ESPIONAGE. MARCONI WAS SHOWERED WITH HONOURS BY MANY COUNTRIES, INCLUDING ITALY WHICH HAD IGNORED HIS GREAT ACHIEVEMENT IN 1896.

FROM THE SAME SOURCE (SPLATTER)

IN HIS CONTROVERSIAL BOOK 'SPYCATCHER' PETER WRIGHT, WHOSE DAD WAS MARCONI'S HEAD OF RESEARCH, DESCRIBED THE CLOSE LINKS BETWEEN MI6 AND MARCONI AFTER WORLD WAR I. BRITAIN WANTED TO DEVELOP A LONG-WAVE RADIO SYSTEM TO SUPPLEMENT THE CABLE LINKS WITH THE EMPIRE. MARCONI URGED THEM TO ADOPT A SHORT-WAVE BEAM SYSTEM WHICH HE WOULD DEVELOP FREE-OF-CHARGE. THE GOVERNMENT AGREED, BUT DEMANDED THE TOUGHEST CONTRACT THEY COULD DEVISE: A LINK WITH SYDNEY, AUSTRALIA, OPERATING 250 WPM FOR 12 HOURS WITH NO MORE THAN 20 KW. DAVID SARNOFF, HEAD OF RCA, SAID "HAS MARCONI GONE MAD? THIS PROJECT WILL FINISH HIM. IT WILL NEVER WORK." THREE MONTHS LATER, THE LINK WAS OPERATING 12 HOURS A DAY FOR SEVEN DAYS AT 350 WPM. WRIGHT CONSIDERED THIS "ONE OF THE GREAT TECHNICAL ACHIEVEMENTS OF THIS CENTURY".
