Amateur Operation On 160-190 kHz

(taken from QST Canada)
In response to a CRRL inquiry,
DOC has advised that it is permit
Canadian amateurs to operate in
the long wave band, 160-190 kHz,
on a case-by-case basis.
Guide-lines were originally set out
in a memorandum sent to DOC

regional offices in March 1988. Some excerpts from this memorandum:

"Subject: Operation on 160-190 kHz by Amateurs"

- "...authority should be issued only on a non-interference basis."
- "we suggest the following criteria:
- 1. field strength must not exceed 10 millivolts per meter at 30 meters,
- 2. bandwidth of the emission used should not normally exceed 3 kHz,
- 3. duration of the authority to be one year from the date of issue,
- 4. authority to operate may be rescinded at any time."

DOC notes that while, normally, only amateurs would become involved with 160-190 kHz operation, the presence of amateur stations on this band would be based on a subsection of the

GENERAL RADIO REGULATIONS, PART II

dealing with stations exempt from licensing. This subsection requires **DOC** approval of equipment which could be done at a **DOC** regional or district office.

In issuing the guidlines, DOC notes that it is not their intention to open up another amateur band for general use, even though there are a few Canadian assignments in the 160-190 kHz range. (Editor)


Still Learning


