### Lions Club 3rd Annual Walk-A-Dog-A-Thon

Seven members of the NSARC provided communications for the 3RD annual Walk-A-Dog-A-Thon which was held on Saturday, October 4, 1997 in Newcastle. The purpose of the walk was to raise money for the LIONS FOUNDATION CANINE VISION TRAINING SCHOOL in Oakville, Ontario (i.e. "seeing eye" dogs) This is the second year the NSARC has been asked to help out with this event. With myself (Gary VE3EPY) operating as the control station, the checkpoints were handled by Les (VA3LTB), Peter (VA3PWH), Martha (VA3SBD), Howard (VE3TYQ), Mike (VE3VCY) and Charlie (VE3UEM). Yes, we even had a "Checkpoint Charlie"! This year saw at least 90 people walking with their dogs up from about 60 folks last year. It is very impressive to note the year-over-year achievements of this Walk-A-Dog-A-Thon. In their first year of this event, the LIONS Club of Newcastle raised over \$7600 towards the sponsorship of the seeing eye dog program where each trained dog costs an average of \$6000. Last year they raised over \$10,000 and this year the pledges are in at just over the \$13,000 mark! At one point during the event Martha reported having a QSO with a GOAT (GOLF ZERO ALPHA TANGO). When I asked Martha what mode of transmission she used for the QSO, CW or SSB, she clarified that she hadn't worked a rare DX station from the North

Atlantic but that she had in fact met up with a GOAT! Realizing my error, I then asked at what speed the goat could send CW? Martha did clarify to say that she did have a conversation with the goat (errr make that the goat's owner). For more details on this, you'll have to ask Martha (will the goat be QSLing via the Bureau Martha?). For those of you that may be wondering, the goat is the LIONS Club's mascot. As was the case last year, there were no instances of any problems or any requirements for emergency services. Once again, the NSARC club members demonstrated the value of Amateur communications by providing regular reports back to the organizers including the important work of assisting to change the route of the walk while it was in progress! WELL DONE TEAM!!! I (Gary VE3EPY) received a nice thankyou letter from the Newcastle LIONS Club which includes an invitation asking us to participate again next year. Mark your calenders for October 3, 1998. Please remember that any NSARC club member is welcome to help out, licensed or not, as we can team you up with a licensed amateur. Finally, many thanks to the members of the team who helped out. You made a difference! Best 73!
